
Getting the Report with the Projected Growth Score

- 1. Log into star
- 2. Go to the section that contains the report (Early Lit, Reading or Math)
- 3. Go to reports
- 4. Choose Instructional Planning Student



5. If you have multiple classes you can choose to view only one by using the drop-down. If you want to combine the report for just a few of your classes, use the link 'classes' (a pop up window appears) and check the box next to the ones you want.

Or if you want to select a few students from across multiple classes, select the 'Students' link. Or you can choose from any groups you may have created.


6. Use the custom date if you want to get closer to the actual day you will be giving the post test. Test could affect the projected score by several points.

7. Click view report and then SAVE IT. This report will change the second the student takes a second assessment!
